COLLECT

God of compassion,
whose Son Jesus Christ, the child of Mary,
shared the life of a home in Nazareth,
and on the cross drew the whole human family
to himself:
strengthen us in our daily living
that in joy and in sorrow
we may know the power of your presence
to bind together and to heal;
through Jesus Christ your Son our Lord,
who is alive and reigns with you,
in the unity of the Holy Spirit,
one God, now and for ever.

READING Colossians 3.12-17

As God's chosen ones, holy and beloved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, meekness, and patience. Bear with one another and, if anyone has a complaint against another, forgive each other; just as the Lord has forgiven you, so you also must forgive. Above all, clothe yourselves with love, which binds everything together in perfect harmony. And let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in the one body. And be thankful. Let the word of Christ dwell in you richly; teach and admonish one another in all wisdom; and with gratitude in your hearts sing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs to God. And whatever you do, in word or deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him.

GOSPEL John 19.25b-27

Meanwhile, standing near the cross of Jesus were his mother, and his mother's sister, Mary the wife of Clopas, and Mary Magdalene. When Jesus saw his mother and the disciple whom he loved standing beside her, he said to his mother, 'Woman, here is your son.' Then he said to the disciple, 'Here is your mother.' And from that hour the disciple took her into his own home.

POST COMMUNION

Loving God,
as a mother feeds her children at the breast
you feed us in this sacrament

help us who have tasted your goodness
to grow in grace within the household of faith;
through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Prepare the person of your choice
for their ministry among us,
and prepare us for their coming;
and overrule in everything for the doing of your will
and the furtherance of your glory;
through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Lord God our Father,
call to this your parish and ours
a true shepherd, a person of God, a minister of Christ;
and make us, with them,
a parish joyful in worship and united in witness,
working, caring, praising, loving,
to the glory of your name;
through Jesus Christ our Lord.

*Pray God's guidance for our archdeacon,
bishop, diocesan staff, area dean, deanery lay
chair and parish representatives:*

Heavenly Father,
guide with your wisdom
all involved in selecting a faithful pastor for our parish,
that, at the end of the process,
we will receive the one who will speak your word,
lead, foster and serve your people according to your will,
through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Pray for our parish life between priests:

Lord Jesus Christ,
Head of the Church,
the work of this parish is yours.
In this time of waiting,
strengthen us through your glorious might
that with patience we may faithfully serve you
and grow in knowing you and your will in our lives.

Pray for yourself and all of us:

Almighty and everlasting God,
by whose Spirit the whole body of the Church
is governed and sanctified:
hear our prayer which we offer for ourselves,
that in our vocation and ministry
we may serve you in holiness and truth
to the glory of your name;
through our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.
