Travel instructions to Dymchurch are as follows.

If coming from Maidstone via the M20 travel to
Junction 11...and take the third exit at the
roundabout for Hythe....travel on this road over the
next roundabout and take the first exit and after a
mile turn left towards Hythe, descending into the
town down Hythe Hill.

Watch out for the 30mph speed cameras at the bottom of the hill. Keep straight over three sets of traffic lights with the RHDR railway station on the right. Turn right on the A259 towards Dymchurch, New Romney and Hastings.

Eventually you will pass the shooting ranges of the MOD on the left, then two caravan parks on the right followed by the Neptune. On the left as you progress you will see a Martello Tower, the signpost Welcome to Dymchurch, the Children's Paradise, then in half a mile Young's Builders Merchants and then in 409 yards on the left The Ship Pub with the Church on the right.

Opposite the pub before the Church is The Rectory 135, High Street TN29 0LD.

This is your destination.....there is plenty of parking at the back of the Rectory as directed on your arrival. Safe travel and see you whenever between the hours of 10am and 4pm

If you are coming the rural route come to Dymchurch Village and progress through the Village towards Hythe. We are on the left after the car wash and garage on the road and just past the Church opposite the Ship Pub.
